We previously worked for a luxury home builder, and we started Mountainwood Homes in 2008 out of necessity to feed our family. We took on small jobs for family and friends and gained momentum. The rest of our team has similar stories. During a recent meeting, we went around the room to add it up, and our team has over 506 years of collective experience in the industry.



What is unique about your business? (What sets you apart from your competition?)

We view ourselves as a customer service company that happens to build great things.



It's not just about the hammer and nails for us; We're thinking about the entire experience and how our client feels throughout the assembly of their project.

Our clients are excited to get started and want expert guidance to solve their home's challenges, but they often ask us the question, "What's the next step?" They want a plan and to be shown the way. We have a team of experts that guide them every step of the way – from designing the space, visualizing it in 3D, to selecting materials, getting through the permitting process, all the way through construction.

Tell us about your team.

Right now, we have 32 people on the Mountainwood team to help bring a project to life.

The process starts by inviting one of our Project Developers out to see the project and understand the frustration with the space. That's how the relationship begins. We have a group of Project Developers who identify the pain points, and then we bring in the Design team to create solutions for the pain.

Then our clients work with our award-winning design team to figure out their personal style and how it will mesh with the style of home and fit within their budget.





